

## Environment Lesson Plan

**Learning objectives:** Learn + practice environment vocabulary through writing and speaking exercises

**Resources:** Environment Warm-up, Environment Worksheet + Answer Key, Environment Game, Environment Filler, Environment Chant, Environment Puzzle + Answer Key, Trash (See Filler), Paper (See Game), Environment Flashcards, Safari Clothes (See Warm-up)

**Preparation Time:** 15 minutes

**Completion Time:** 60 minutes (2 x 30 mins.)

**Skill/Grammar:** Writing/Vocabulary/Listening/Pre-Reading

**Age/Level:** Pre-Primary/ Beginner

**Warm-Up – 10 minutes**

- Follow the **Teaching Notes** on the sheet for instructions

**Presentation + Practice – 40-45 minutes**

- While the students finish coloring their animals, play some music and walk around the class, admiring their work.

- Hand out the puzzle to students.
- Individually, students practice writing and then find the words in the search. (Note: If students are new to writing in English, show them the proper way to write the letters on the board.)
- While the students are finishing the puzzle, play some music and walk around the class admiring their work.
