What is Cambridge English CELTA?

The Cambridge Certificate in English Teaching to Adults is an initial qualification for people who want to become teachers of English as a foreign language but have little or no previous teaching experience. It is the most highly regarded and widely recognised qualification for new English language teachers and is awarded by **Cambridge English**, which is part of Cambridge University. The course focuses on the principles of effective teaching, provides a range of practical skills for teaching English to adult learners and gives hands-on teaching practice.

- 20 hours of lesson preparation, initially supervised by the course tutors
- 4 written assignments
- At least one individual tutorial to review progress

The CELTA course is full-time course (35 hours per week) and normally takes place within the hours 0900-1800, Monday-Friday.

The fees include:

- 35 hours per week tution
- Materials, including course file, handouts, city map, information on Norwich and final certification
- Use of resource centre and library
- Free Internet access and use of computer

Accommodation in Norwich:

Homestay accommodation can be provided in single study-bedrooms with carefully selected hosts. It comprises bed, breakfast & evening meal each day and light lunch (or packed lunch as appropriate) at weekends.

Residential accommodation (self-catering) can be provided on

campus at the University of East Anglia. This comprises single study-bedrooms with private bathroom. There is a fully-equipped, shared kitchen/dining room. Please note that this option is only available from June to September. The present cost of accommodation is 196 per week. If you require help in finding alternative accommodation, please let us know.
