- materials, including course file, handouts, city map, information on Norwich and attendance certificate
- use of resource centre and library
- free wifi and access to computer centre
- social programme comprising evening activities and, for 2-week courses, a weekend excursion to places of interest e.g. Cambridge and the Norfolk Coast

Accommodation in Norwich

- **# Homestay accommodation** is provided in single study-bedrooms with carefully selected hosts. It comprises bed, breakfast & evening meal each day and light lunch (or packed lunch as appropriate) at weekends.
- ** Residential accommodation is provided on campus at the University of East Anglia in single study-bedrooms with private bathroom. The accommodation is on a self-catering basis in university 'houses' or 'flats' with a shared kitchen/dining room, fully equipped for self-catering.
