Accommodation in Norwich

Homestay accommodation is provided in single study-bedrooms with carefully selected hosts. It comprises bed, breakfast & evening meal each day and light lunch (or packed lunch as appropriate) at weekends.

Residential accommodation is provided on the campus of the University of East Anglia in single study-bedrooms with private bathroom. The accommodation is on a self-catering basis in university 'houses' or 'flats' with a shared kitchen/dining room, fully equipped for self-catering.
